## Rules of Procedure:

### Proper Representation Space Generation Advisory Council (SGAC)

- All international/regional/national representation (see bullet 4) of the organization should be coordinated through the Executive Office and if necessary the Co-Chairpersons.
- Anyone wishing to represent SGAC at various events, committees, forums must inform the SGAC Executive Office before the event occurs and the SGAC Executive Office has a right to disapprove such activity if there are important reasons.
- If a person is approved to represent SGAC in an event, he or she must submit a report that can be filed from each instance of representation within a period of one week.
- If the SGAC delegate is asked to make a speech, presentation or any kind of contribution on behalf of the SGAC he or she must send it in advance to the Executive Office [officer@spacegeneration.org](mailto:officer@spacegeneration.org) for approval.
- If one or all of these criteria are not fulfilled, serious consequences will follow.
