SGAC has come a long way since its creation at UNISPACE III in 1999. Our membership is expanding in numbers to over 2000 and participation in our projects is increasing. As a measure of the impact of our work this year we were invited to participate in or co-organised no less than seven conferences, including the prestigious Future of Space Exploration Congress on April 12 in Boston, USA where we presented the results of our project "Visions for the next 50 years of space exploration".

Over the past 18 months we have been steering the SGAC in the direction of stability and consistency of output. We established an office in Vienna, which we have maintained for the past year. We now have three staff, the Executive Director Chris Boshuizen based in Sydney, the Executive Officer Agnieszka Lukaszczyk based in Vienna, and a part time Manager for our annual space conference Kevin Stube. These three individuals have been charged with increasing the output for our organisation, by tapping all of the great ideas and energy of our community. The results are already beginning to show!

To support our continued growth and to allow us to maintain and expand our office, we are seeking your help with our key challenge: finding funds to support our activity and growth. We anticipate increased spending as we shift some staff to full time and with the placement of several interns over 2008. Funding is also required to support some of our key projects.

To help things keep going and growing, we are conducting a fundraising campaign with the target of 100,000 Euros. With this we hope to support some the basic cost of the organisation for the following year, with additional funding coming from our project sponsors.
